An overview of data protection

General

The following gives a simple overview of what happens to your personal information when you visit our website. Personal information is any data with which you could be personally identified. Detailed information on the subject of data protection can be found in our privacy policy found below.

Data collection on our website

Who is responsible for the data collection on this website?

The data collected on this website are processed by the website operator. The operator's contact details can be found in the website.

How do we collect your data?

Some data are collected when you provide it to us. This could, for example, be data you enter on a contact form.

Other data are collected automatically by our IT systems when you visit the website. These data are primarily technical data such as the browser and operating system you are using or when you accessed the page. These data are collected automatically as soon as you enter our website.

What do we use your data for?

Part of the data is collected to ensure the proper functioning of the website. Other data can be used to analyze how visitors use the site.

What rights do you have regarding your data?

You always have the right to request information about your stored data, its origin, its recipients, and the purpose of its collection at no charge. You also have the right to request that it be corrected, blocked, or deleted. You can contact us at any time using the address given in the legal notice if you have further questions about the issue of privacy and data protection. You may also, of course, file a complaint with the competent regulatory authorities.

Analytics and third-party tools

Our website do not use cookies.

When visiting our website, statistical analyses may be made of your surfing behavior. This happens primarily using analytics. The analysis of your surfing behavior is usually anonymous, i.e. we will not be able to identify you from this data. You can object to this analysis or prevent it by not using certain tools. Right to data portability

You have the right to have data which we process based on your consent or in fulfillment of a contract automatically delivered to yourself or to a third party in a standard, machine-readable format. If you require the direct transfer of data to another responsible party, this will only be done to the extent technically feasible.

SSL or TLS encryption

Cookies

Our website do not use any cookies.

Server log files

The website provider automatically collects and stores information that your browser automatically transmits to us in "server log files". These are:

Browser type and browser version

Operating system used

Referrer URL

Host name of the accessing computer

Time of the server request

IP address

These data will not be combined with data from other sources.

The basis for data processing is Art. 6 (1) (f) DSGVO, which allows the processing of data to fulfill a contract or for measures preliminary to a contract.

Contact form

Should you send us questions via the contact form, we will collect the data entered on the form, including the contact details you provide, to answer your question and any follow-up questions. We do not share this information without your permission.

We will, therefore, process any data you enter onto the contact form only with your consent. You may revoke your consent at any time. An informal email making this request is sufficient. The data processed before we receive your request may still be legally processed.

We will retain the data you provide on the contact form until you request its deletion, revoke your consent for its storage, or the purpose for its storage no longer pertains (e.g. after fulfilling your request). Any mandatory statutory provisions, especially those regarding mandatory data retention periods, remain unaffected by this provision.

Analytics and advertising

Google Analytics

This website uses Google Analytics, a web analytics service. It is operated by Google Inc., 1600 Amphitheatre Parkway, Mountain View, CA 94043, USA.

Google Analytics uses so-called "cookies". These are text files that are stored on your computer and that allow an analysis of the use of the website by you. Data protection information for business partners

Data protection in the event of job applications

The person responsible for the processing collects and processes the personal data of applicants for the purpose of handling the recruitment process in accordance with Art. 6, sec. 1, lit b.(if necessary, lit f) DS-GVO (German d and § 26 sec. 1 of BDSG- neu (German Data Protection Act new version). No additional processing going further than that takes place or does so only with your consent.

If the person responsible for the data processing concludes an employment contract with an applicant, the transmitted data will be further processed for the purpose of managing the employment relationship while observing the statutory regulations.

If no employment contract is concluded with the applicant by the person responsible for data processing, the application details will automatically be erased six months after the announcement of the refusal, as long as no other legitimate interests of the person responsible for data processing preclude a deletion. Another legitimate interest in this sense is, for example, the burden of proof in legal proceedings under the General Equality of Treatment Act (AGG).

In addition, during the application procedure, you have the following rights against the person

Responsible for data processing:

Information, correction, deletion, blocking, data transmission together with a right to limitation of processing. Equally, there is a right to surrender the data provided by you in a structured, conventional and machine-suitable format. There is also a right to withdrawal and objection.

The responsible party must be informed of any revocation of the processing. In this case your application can no longer be considered for the application process.
